AS-BUILT REQUIREMENTS FOR SEWER ADOPTIONS



'As Built' drawings and manhole record cards should be supplied by the Developer once sewer construction is completed.

The drawings and manhole record cards should be sent electronically and should be submitted in the following way and to the standards set out below.

All drawing must be labelled 'AS-BUILT'

This information should be shown on the entire length of the adoptable network.		
Drawing must also show full details of • existing sewers • road gullies • watercourses • existing and proposed buildings Location of the point of connection to the existing public sewer to be shown on As Build drawing.

O and M Manuals		Electronic Copy, Hard Copy to remain in the kiosk on site.

A Manhole Record Sheet should be completed for each manhole.

Developers must use South West Water manhole cards. The Manhole Record Cards can be downloaded from our website: www.southwestwater.co.uk/ . You will also be able to view a worked example for information.

Levels should refer to the relevant Ordnance Survey bench marks.
