

As-built requirements for sewer adoptions/sewer diversions

'As Built' drawings and manhole record cards (MHRC) should be supplied by the Developer once sewer construction is completed.

The drawings and manhole record cards should be sent electronically and should be submitted in the following way and to the standards set out below.

Drawing

All drawing must be labelled 'AS-BUILT'

Scale: 1:200; 1:500; 1:1250

(Dependent on size of development appropriate scale to be used)

Format: 1 x Auto Cad file DWF/DGN and 1 x PDF

The drawing should show detailed layout of:

- Roads
- Gravity sewers
- Pumping stations
- Rising mains

Sewers to be adopted:

- New foul colour: brown solid line
- New surface water colour: dark blue solid line
- New rising main colours as above with direction of flow
- Pipe diameter
- Pipe gradient
- Cover level and invert level for manholes
- Direction of flow
- Pipe materials
- Pipe length to be shown along the entire length
- Private sewers colour black line type: -- -- -- --

For the diversion of public sewers (Section 185 of the Water Industry Act)

- Proposed abandoned public sewers colour: black solid line with hatching or \\\\\\\\\\\\\
- New combined sewers colour: red solid line

This information should be shown on the entire length of the adoptable network. Drawing must also show full details of:

- Existing sewers:
 - o foul: black dashed line 150 mm 1/83 -----
 - o surface water black dashed line 225 mm 1/156
 - o combined black line 300 mm 1/150
- Road gullies
- Watercourses colour: light blue
- Existing and proposed buildings
- Easements shown highlighted with a yellow strip



Location of the point of connection to the existing public sewer to be shown on As Built drawing, including extract of existing sewers.

Pumping station layout

Scale: 1:50; 1:100

Additional scale as required: 1:200; 1:500; 1:1250

(Dependent on size of development appropriate scale to be used)

1 x Auto Cad file DWF/DGN and 1 x PDF

Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Manuals

Electronic copy

Hard Copy to remain in the kiosk on site

Manhole Record Sheets or Cards (MHRC)

A Manhole Record Sheet should be completed for each manhole.

Developers must use South West Water manhole cards. The Manhole Record Cards can be downloaded from our website:
